

Rishav Ghosh (Born: 12 January, 2000) has written and directed over thirty corporate films, another thirty promotional films, and more than ten independent fiction and non-fiction projects; the most notable being Synthetic Sati (2019), available on Hoichoi and Amazon Prime Video, alongside Agamani (2019), streaming on Addatimes. Recognised by Times of India as one of the youngest filmmakers of India, Ghosh's work has garnered accolades, including the Dadasaheb Phalke Film Festival Award for Best Director (Student). A two-time Gold Medallist from his universities, Ghosh is a Film Studies post-graduate (Jadavpur University, Kolkata, India) and a Film & Television Production graduate (Amity University, Noida, India). He has authored two novels: Sanjivaneer Sandhane (2013), and Eighteen Scars (2014). He has worked in Eastern India's biggest media organisation, SVF Entertainment Pvt. Ltd., as Film Director of 'New Media' Department, directing the promotional campaigns of blockbuster Bengali feature-films like Golondaaj (2021). Presently, he is frontlining the business development and leading the 'Film Division' of Power Publishers & Motion Pictures. Ghosh plans to launch Bonbibi Studios, a sustainable-filmmaking organisation aimed to discover, incubate, and launch young artists and storytellers from India, Bangladesh, and overseas - to make the next generation of Bengali immersive media content.
